- John Culp Okanogan TIB denied funding for 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue Received delivery of new fire truck
- Kelly Scalf TranGo Introduced Kim Webb, TranGo Administrative Assistant
- Dennis Brown Tonasket Received delivery of 2 new police cars, are working on the Police Station and on a sewer project.
