Update: Okanogan County Report

Chairman Neal reported that Okanogan County is working with Okanogan Conservation District as part of the various partners across County to update the Community Wildfire Protection Plan. There will be a planning session this coming Wednesday, February 14, 2024, at the Okanogan Conservation District Office at 9:00a a.m. They will be discussing hazard risk analysis components, projects, and prioritization standards and community meetings.

County Engineer, Thomson, explained that some road restrictions will be lifted.

Update: Washington State Department of Transportation

WSDOT Region Planning Manager, Shaun Darveshi, explained the SR 155 Omak Area Paving and Complete Streets Project overview. This project will construct sidewalks or a shared-use path along State Route 155 Spur/Omak Avenue to provide a designated route for pedestrians and bicyclists to the East Omak Elementary School and across the nearby railroad tracks. Traffic calming features such as speed feedback signs and pedestrian crossing warning lights may also be added to support safer pedestrian travel along and across the roadway.

County-Wide Emergency Updates/Discussion

Okanogan Public Health Director, Lauri Jones said that Okanogan County residents have been getting COVID-19 and Influenza. Both illnesses are having a prolonged cough.

Okanogan County Emergency Management, Maurice Goodall provided his report on weather conditions.
