Update: Treasurer's Report

Treasurer/County Engineer Thomson reported after all expenses have been paid there is currently \$3,750 left in the budget. This does take into account all bills and insurance. The WA State Auditor report has been submitted.

Update: Okanogan County Report

Treasurer/County Engineer Thomson reported on the following:

- Flooding problems have cleared up.
- Paving will take place on Old Hwy 97, south of Malott, from Wednesday through Monday.
- The Twisp River Road contractor has started paving. Also, next month there will be a
 bridge rehab project on Twisp River Road and there will be one lane traffic control for
 approximately one month.

Update: Washington State Department of Transportation

WSDOT North Central Region Planning Manager, Shaun Darveshi, reported the following:

Regarding the Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP), the region applied for a
Connecting Community grant which has been approved. They are now awaiting an award
letter. The grant will focus on the City of Okanogan, and he will reach out to those needed
within a month or two.

- A burn restriction will be imposed from June 15, 2023, through October 15, 2023. There
 will be no burning allowed for unincorporated areas in the county. There also may be a
 burn ban put in place during part of that time.
- Flooding has slowed down but there may be some flash flooding due to intense rains.
- On Tuesday, June 13, 2023, there will be another wind event with possible 40-50 mph gusts. The last windstorm on June 8th took the roof off an airplane hangar at the Okanogan Airport hit a power line and caused a fire off Hwy 97, above the old Okanogan Armory.

Action: Approval of 2040 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) for the Okanogan Region

Secretary Timm reminded Council the current 2040 RTP needed to be reviewed and discussed every two years and updated only when warranted. If Council agreed the current plan still aligned with OCOG's goals, then a letter addressed to WSDOT needs to be drafted stating such. There were no objections or needed changes mentioned by Council.

Secretary Timm moved to approve the Chairman sign a letter stating the RTP has been reviewed and aligns with the plans for the county. The motion was seconded by Treasurer/County Engineer Thomson.
